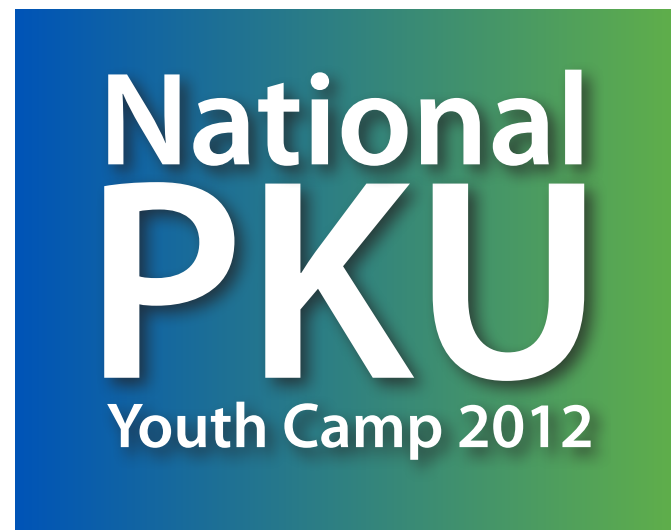

Who can come? You must be aged between 8 and 17 and have PKU to be eligible to attend the camp.

Important dates to remember:

Register your interest by 30th November 2011 to receive your "Camper Information Pack" in December. (Registering by this date will allow us to confirm the number of campers)

Secure your place with a your campers deposit no later than 31st January 2012:
Members \$100
Non-members \$150

The camp coincides with NSW School Holidays and will be held from Monday 1st October until Friday 5th October 2012.

How much does it cost?
